

- 1. The nylon spacer goes on first. There should be a slight gap between the lower bearing housing and the spacer. The nylon spacer should not rub on the housing or it will act as a brake.
- 2. The jam nut goes on next followed by 2 or 3 brass washers. The prop goes on next. Be sure to use some anti-sieze on the shaft when threading on the prop. Tighten the jam nut against the brass washers and the prop.
- 3. Another nylon spacer goes onto the shaft after the prop, followed by a jam nut and a nylock nut. Tighten the jam nut against the nylon spacer and the prop. Finally tighten the nylock nut against the jam nut.
