Decoy Hauler Instructions

PARTS LIST

| Item # | Qty | Description |
|--------|-----|--|
| 1. | 1 | Plastic Marsh Brown Sled with tow rope |
| 2. | 1 | Decoy Bag |
| 3. | 10 | Small self tapping screws |

Tools required


Drill and Phillips bit or Phillips screwdriver

1. Slide the decoy bag over the top of the sled with the mesh drain at the back of the sled.





Mesh drain at the back of the sled.

2. Attach plastic trim lock to the lip of the sled. Bend the trimlock out so it will slip over and clip onto the lip of the sled. It must be opened up with your hand in order for it to fit onto the lip. Work your way down to the end once it has been started.



3. Work the trim lock onto the lip all the way around the sled. Use the small self tapping screws to help hold the trim lock on at some of the ends and where the sled bends.





Completed decoy hauler with trim lock attached all the way around. There should be a gap at each corner.



Rope attached to the front of the sled. Self tapping screws attached at ends of trim lock. These are optional and may not be necessary.
